Mike Pompeo to speak on February 5, 2023



The Honorable Mike Pompeo will speak at the James E. Holshouser Jr. Speaker Series on Sunday, Feb. 5, 2023 at Sandhills Community College's BPAC in Pinehurst.

Pompeo served under President <u>Donald Trump</u> as <u>director of the Central Intelligence Agency</u> (CIA) from 2017 to 2018 and as the <u>70th United States</u> <u>Secretary of State</u> from 2018 to 2021.

After graduating from the <u>United States Military</u> <u>Academy</u> in 1986, and serving in the Army, Pompeo earned a law degree, worked as an attorney, and became an entrepreneur in the aerospace and

oilfield industries. Pompeo was elected to the <u>House of Representatives</u> from 2011 to 2017, representing <u>Kansas's 4th congressional district</u>.
